- 3. have obtained a bachelor's degree and have at least five (5) years of managerial experience related to the course selected to meet the admission requirement of the GIMI;
- 4. **not** be an OAS staff or individual who maintains employment contracts with the OAS or a staff of a Permanent Mission to the OAS or immediate relatives of a staff of a Permanent Mission to the OAS; and
- 5. have not received other scholarship from the OAS for the same level of studies and/or programme of study as advertised in this announcement.
