MOTION

By the Honourable Minister for Health and Wellness and Leader of Government Business:

1. **BE IT RESOLVED** that Parliament authorizes the Minister for Finance to borrow by means of advances sums not exceeding fifty-five million dollars from commercial banks, for a period of six months from the date hereof, which sums shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
2. **BE IT RESOLVED** that Parliament authorizes the Minister for Finance to borrow US\$6,000,000.00 by way of credit (in this Resolution referred to as “the Credit”) from the International Development Association for capital expenditure for the OECS Regional Health Project;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that –

- (a) The Maximum Commitment Charge Rate payable on the Unwithdrawn Financing Balance is $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% per annum;
- (b) a Service Charge is payable on the Withdrawn Credit Balance that is equal to the greater of –
 - (i) the sum of $\frac{3}{4}$ of 1% per annum plus the Basis Adjustment, and
 - (ii) $\frac{3}{4}$ of 1% per annum;
- (c) an Interest Charge is payable on the Withdrawn Credit Balance that is equal to the greater of –
 - (i) the sum of one and $\frac{1}{4}$ % per annum plus the Basis Adjustment, and

- (ii) 0% per annum; and
- (d) the principal amount of the Credit is repayable on each 15th day of February and 15th day of August –
 - (i) commencing on the 15th day of August, 2029 to, and including, the 15th day of February, 2039 at the rate of 1%, and
 - (ii) commencing on the 15th day of August, 2039 to, and including, the 15th day of February, 2059 at the rate of 2%.
