

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES, VETERINARY AND LIVESTOCK SERVICES DIVISION CONDITIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF PET BIRDS INTO ST. LUCIA

- 1. The birds can only be imported through the Seaports of Castries and Vieux Fort or the George FL Charles and Hewanorra Airport.
- 2. The birds must be accompanied by an Import Permit obtained from the Veterinary and livestock Services Division at the request of the prospective importer or his/her representative) An Export Health Certificate issued and obtained from the Veterinary Authority of the country of origin.
- 3. The Veterinary Certificate as in (2) above shall state that:
 - i. The birds have been inspected on the day of exportation and found to be healthy and free from clinical signs of any infectious/contagious disease.
 - ii. There has been no outbreak of New Castle Disease or Avian Influenza (fowl Plague) in the country of origin for the past three (3) years.
- 4. On arrival in St. Lucia birds shall immediately undergo forty-five (45) days of chlortetracycline treatment, the cost of which shall be borne by the owner.
