

Zika Virus Disease

A disease spread by the bite of a female *Aedes aegypti* mosquito infected with the Zika virus.

Signs and symptoms

Symptoms usually begin 3 to 7 days after being bitten.

Pain behind the eyes

Red eyes

Rash

Headache

Fever

Muscle pain



Complications of Zika Virus Disease

In early pregnancy Zika infection may be associated with babies being born with smaller heads.

Other persons may develop paralysis

Prevent the spread of Zika

- Wear long sleeves and long pants
- Use insect repellent
- Use a fan or air conditioner when sleeping
- Sleep under a mosquito net
- Ensure all water containers are properly covered
