A disease spread by the bite of a female Aedes aegypti mosquito infected with the Zika Virus.



Signs and symptoms

Symptoms usually begin 3 to 7 days after being bitten.

Pain behind the eyes



Headache

Prevent the spread of Zika

- · Wear long sleeves and long pants
- · use insect repellent
- · Use a fan or air conditioner when sleeping
- · Sleep under a mosquito net
- Ensure all water containers are properly covered

associated with babies
being born with
smaller heads.
Other persons may
develop paralysis
