- iv. Demonstrated experience and skills project management
- v. Experience in researching and analysing trends and prices for services and goods.
- vi. Demonstrated experience and skills in delivering training would be an asset.
- vii. Demonstrated competence and knowledge of principles, practices and procedures governing procurement.
- viii. Excellent negotiation skills.
- ix. High proficiency in spoken and written English.
- x. Fully conversant with Microsoft Suite of products (Excel, Word, PowerPoint, etc.), collaborative tools and other related procurement software.
