Responsibilities of The Leader of The Party

Each party must be accompanied by a leader travelling on a valid individual passport who will be responsible for the party's observance of all formalities, including customs, health, immigration and currency controls; for keeping the party together and for retaining the collective travel documents.

All persons named in the collective document must travel together to and from their destination and must remain together during their stay.

In the event of a member of the party travelling on a collective travel document becoming separated from the party or being unable to travel back to his country of residence with the rest of the party for reasons beyond his control, the leader of the party must inform the local immigration authorities and, if possible, the Chief Immigration Officer, Saint Lucia by cable. He must in any case, inform the immigration authorities of the absence of any member of his party at the time of its departure. Any person not leaving with his party must, if required, obtain an individual travel document from the nearest Passport authorities.

Collective travel documents shall be issued in original to the leader of the party, who should provide himself with as many copies as may be required for presentation at the Immigration authorities of the countries to be visited.

Each member of a party travelling on a collective passport must be in possession of an individual identity card bearing a photograph and the official stamp and seal &c., of the Government of Saint Lucia. Persons without identity cards must be in possession of a photograph which must be certified by the leader and stamped by the immigration officer. School children will be exempted from this requirement.
