SAFETY EQUIPMENT LIST

AS per FISHERIES REGULATIONS SI 1994, No.9

Bailer: to remove water

Compass: Hand held/mounted to indicate direction [\$120-\$155]

Water containers: for drinking water to sustain life until rescue [\$10]

Oars: in case of engine failure [\$15/pair]

Sail: in case of engine failure [\$500]

Flashlight: Battery operated, water proof for signaling [\$12/\$128]

Food stores: Long shelf life items, e.g. biscuit, canned foodstuffs [\$20].

Small glass mirror: for signaling using sunlight and moonlight [\$5]

Flare kit: 2-day flares and 2-night flares for signaling [\$60/\$325]

Sea anchor: to reduce drifting speed [\$199]

Lifejackets: One per person for floatation [\$30/\$60]

Radar reflector: Cardboard rapped in foil paper to show position on RADAR
[\$10]

OPTIONAL: Recommended by Dept. of Fisheries

First-Aid kit: for medical attention [\$56/\$200]

Basic tool kit: for basic repairs [\$30]

Whistle: to attract attention [\$1/\$13]

GPS: *Global Positioning System* to indicate position [\$500+]

VHF radio: *Very High Frequency* to communicate position [\$500/\$800]

Other long-range **communication** devices e.g. cell phones [\$100+]
